DR. MARIA SUBERT

Maria Subert earned her first M.A. in Philosophy at Eotvos Lorant University in Budapest, Hungary. She continued her studies at the Goethe University, in Frankfurt am Main, Germany. She received a second master’s and a doctorate at the Scripps College of Communication at Ohio University in Athens. She graduated in Communication Studies, specializing in Rhetoric and Public Culture, and finished her post-graduate studies in 2020, at the United Nations Institute for Training and Research, in Geneva, Switzerland, specializing in conflict and crisis communication.

Maria works with P-CoC because she believes we can change our attitudes by connecting with one another more frequently and interacting at a depth well past the stereotypes. She emphasizes that “We must challenge and call out such stereotypes. I know this is not easy. We need to work on these changes consciously and persistently to increase awareness of ourselves and our responses to others, to learn their history and culture, to remain open-minded, and to live together sustainably as inclusive and equal human beings.”
